RE: April Meeting

Main Presentation: This month we welcome Rich Fronek. Rich is the current General Commanding of the MHRT. He initially joined in 1985 and has served in a variety of officer roles since that time. Rich grew up on a family dairy farm near Antigo, Wisconsin. During his formative years he took great interest in the Civil War (which he shared with his father) and family history and genealogy (which he shared with his mother). These two interests intersect in Rich's presentation titled; "*Andrew Jackson Bovee and the Battle of the Wilderness*". The story of the life of Andrew Jackson Bovee includes many coincidences with family, Wisconsin, Madison and the pioneer spirit. Rich's career was involved with engineering in the medical field of cardiology and medical imaging. But his love of family and Civil War history brings us his presentation today.
